

## **Metronome Prague 2022 Festival Rules**

### **1. Opening Provisions**

1.1 The Festival Rules have been issued by Metronome Production, spol. s r.o. ID#: 04658639, headquartered at Terronská 873/3, Praha 6, 160 00 registered in the Commercial Registry kept by the Prague Municipal Court, section C, entry 251541 (referred to from here as “Organizer”), and they dictate the basic rules for individuals entering the Metronome Prague festival and using equipment located in the Metronome Prague Festival grounds (referred to from here as “Festival Rules”).

1.2 The purpose of the Festival Rules is to ensure security, fire prevention, hygienic conditions, health, and safety at the Metronome Prague Festival and to provide ideal conditions for all events (referred to from here as “Events”), art of Metronome Prague and to ensure a pleasant atmosphere.

1.3 The Metronome Prague Festival grounds are clearly marked spaces at Výstaviště Praha.

1.4 The Metronome Prague Festival grounds will be open to the public as follows: on 23.6.2022 from 15:30 to 04:00; on 24.6.2022 from 15:00 to 04:00; and on 25.6.2022 from 13:00 to 04:00.

1.5 The Festival grounds are clearly marked, and entrance is only granted based on a valid ticket or other token determined by the Organizer if the event is not free of charge. By presenting a purchased ticket when entering the grounds, the attendee expresses consent with these Festival Rules, which become binding for every attendee upon entering the grounds and throughout their stay. For these rules, an Attendee is considered to be any individual attending Metronome Prague, including media representatives, technical personnel, or other individuals. These rules are valid for all individuals entering the Metronome Prague Festival grounds on the basis of a special or other contractual relationship with the Organizer or other contracted partners.

### **2. Metronome Prague Festival Grounds**

2.1 The purchase of tickets or the reception of an ID band completes a contract on participation at Metronome Prague between the Attendee and the Organizer. Each Attendee of the event/festival except for events with free admission will receive an ID band upon presenting a purchased ticket that authorizes them to enter the grounds and replaces the ticket. A ticket is understood as a printed ticket for individual entrance to the event/festival or an electronic version (e.g. an e-ticket) granting a specific individual access to the Festival. Each individual attending Metronome Prague must wear their ID band or other credentials granting access throughout their stay at the grounds and show when asked by representatives of the organizer or security personnel.

Anyone not able to show their credentials for entrance to Metronome Prague may not be granted access to the grounds or may be removed from the grounds.

Visitor and public access to the grounds and its individual zones is granted access by the Organizer during opening hours and according to these Festival Rules. Any complaints can only be considered before entering the grounds.

2.2 Representatives of the Organizer are charged with overseeing the upholding of these rules at the Metronome Prague Festival, as are the Czech Police and the Prague Municipal Police.

2.3 Individuals under the influence of alcohol or other drugs as well as those that threaten the health or safety of others or the property within the Metronome Prague Festival grounds forfeit the right to attend Metronome Prague and may not be allowed access or may be removed from the grounds by representatives of the Organizer or security personnel.

Individuals that violate these Festival Rules or ignore instructions from representatives of the Organizer may also be denied access to Metronome Prague or removed from the festival grounds.

2.4 Individuals not admitted to or removed from the Metronome Prague Festival grounds according to these rules are not entitled to any refund for the charges of admission. Individuals can have their access to Metronome Prague limited or denied according to these provisions.

2.5 The sale of alcoholic beverage and tobacco products to individuals under the age of 18 is strictly prohibited at the Metronome Prague Festival grounds in accordance with valid laws.

### 3. Attendee Obligations

3.1 Attendees of Metronome Prague are obligated to behave in a way that does not threaten their own health and safety or that of others or any property at the Metronome Prague Festival grounds and not limit, threaten, or irritate other attendees beyond a reasonable level corresponding to the conditions of Metronome Prague.

3.2 Attendees of Metronome Prague are obligated to follow instructions from representatives of the Organizer or security personnel as well as those from the Czech Police, Prague Municipal Police, or Rescue Services.

3.3 Attendees of Metronome Prague are obligated to respect these Festival Rules, general legal regulations, as well as social norms and the rules of polite behaviour.

3.4 Attendees of Metronome Prague are forbidden from bringing the following items into the Festival grounds:

- a) Racist, defamatory, vulgar, or other materials that violate good morals
- b) Weapons of any kind and any slashing, piercing, or other objects that could be a threat to safety, health, or the life of Attendees (i.e. scissors, umbrellas, etc.)
- c) Sprays, adhesives, perfumes of more than 200 ml, explosives, dyes, or other flammable or hazardous materials
- d) Glass bottles, dishes, cans, or other materials made from materials that can break or are very hard
- e) Fireworks, rockets, flares, smoke bombs or other pyrotechnic materials
- e) Alcoholic beverages, non-alcoholic beverages, and drugs
- f) Animals with the exception of service dogs for the physically handicapped
- g) Promotional materials, be they political, commercial, or other
- h) Large luggage, bikes, or other vehicles with the exception of those necessary for movement
- i) Umbrellas
- j) Laser pointers
- k) Recording equipment, video cameras, and semi- or fully professional cameras and SLRs.

The Organizer reserves the right to decide about the danger of individual items Attendees want to take into the Metronome Prague Festival grounds, specifically the security personnel. Checks can be performed before entrance to the grounds and throughout the individual's time within the grounds. Attendees can be asked by the representatives of the Organizer to place inappropriate items or large luggage in the storage service located in the grounds. The decisions of these individuals are binding for Attendees.

3.5 Attendees of Metronome Prague are obligated to allow the representatives of the Organizer to inspect items and luggage brought into the grounds to check compliance with the previous provision. If the Attendee refuses inspection, they can be denied access to or be removed from Metronome Prague.

3.6 Attendees of Metronome Prague agree to security inspections to ensure compliance with these rules, both luggage and a bodily inspection performed by representatives of the Organizer or security

personnel when entering grounds. If the Attendee refuses inspection, they can be denied access to or be removed from Metronome Prague.

3.7 Attendees of Metronome Prague are further prohibited from:

- a) Expressing, spreading, or publicly supporting racist, defamatory, vulgar, or other slogans and images that violate good morals or to incite such behaviour
- b) Promote any political party or movement or a product or service
- c) Climb on or enter any building on the grounds or climb facades, fences, walls, barriers, lighting equipment, trees, columns, roofs, boards, supporting constructions, etc.
- d) Entering non-public areas that are labelled as inaccessible
- e) Throw any items into spaces with other people, especially into crowds, fields, or on stage
- f) Make any audio recordings or capture visual images at the Metronome Prague Festival for commercial purposes or to photograph the performances with semi-professional or professional cameras and SLRs without the prior written consent of the Organizer
- g) Smoke in any areas that are not designated as smoking areas
- h) Bring beverages into the Metronome Prague grounds
- i) Light fires or use any sort of fireworks or pyrotechnics
- j) To wilfully manipulate equipment located within the grounds
- k) Manipulate water, electric, air, or other systems within the grounds
- l) Damage any equipment within the grounds including trees, bushes, and grasses
- m) Write on, cover up, or paint any equipment or paths within the grounds
- n) Relieve oneself outside the toilets or to pollute the grounds in any other way
- o) Drive into the grounds without the prior consent or instructions from the Organizer or an authorized individual
- p) Threaten or commit violence toward another individual or group, or incite violence
- q) Sell tickets or any other goods without prior consent
- r) Distribute or place any promotional materials in the Festival grounds without the prior written consent of the Organizer!
- s) Enter the grounds with dogs or other animals!

3.8 Attendees are not permitted to undertake any commercial or similar activities or to distribute or sell any items to other attendees including flyers, printed materials, advertising materials, etc within the Metronome Prague grounds. without prior written consent from the Organizer or in violation of the conditions of the permit, nor can any items be stored on the Metronome Prague grounds.

3.9 The Attendee participates in the festival on their own responsibility and is responsible for any damages caused. The Attendee is aware that taking off the ID band voids their contract and then they are not allowed to demand access to the Festival.

3.10 To maintain safety, Attendees are obligated to:

- a) Provide adequate personal and material aid in cases of fires, natural disasters, or other extraordinary event while not exposing themselves or their loved ones to serious danger or if they are prevented from doing so by serious circumstances
- b) Dispose of butts and other tobacco products only into containers for that purpose and to be careful when lighting tobacco products (matches, lighters)
- c) Not smoke in buildings and spaces labelled with a “Zákaz kouření” (No Smoking) sign
- d) Not damage safety signage
- e) Not damage or limit the use of installed hand-held fire extinguishers in any way
- f) Not damage or limit the use of the hydrant system or other fire prevention equipment in any way
- g) Not damage or interfere with installed electrical systems in any way
- h) Not damage or in any way limit the use of controlling elements in installed technical equipment (electrical cabinets, circuit breakers, main water shut-off valves, etc.)
- i) To follow instructions from of the organizers of the event, members of the fire prevention team, security personnel, and any rescue service personnel in the case of a fire

#### 4. Responsibility for Damages

4.1 The Organizer is not responsible for property damage or damage to the health of the Attendee if this damage is not caused by a violation of legal regulations by the Organizer and directly related to this violation.

4.2 Attendees, especially older and handicapped individuals must be careful on smooth and uneven surfaces in their own interest to avoid accidents. The Organizer is not responsible for damages from an injury caused by the Attendees own carelessness or violation of the Festival Rules.

4.3 Attendees are obligated to give any and all items found on the Festival grounds to representatives of the Organizer or security personnel.

If Attendees find any suspicious item or items within the Metronome Prague Festival Grounds that could threaten property, lives, or the health of third parties, they must be immediately report them to the representatives of the Organizer or security personnel. Every Attendee is responsible to the Organizer and any third party for damages caused by violating these Festival Rules or other legal regulations.

4.4 The Organizer has the right to demand the Attendee hand over any item that caused damage to the Organizer or injured or caused damage to a third party.

4.5 Attendees are obligated to report any injuries or damages incurred within the Metronome Prague Festival grounds to representatives of the Organizer or security personnel.

4.6 If the Metronome Prague Festival grounds are evacuated or in any other extraordinary situation, Attendees are obligated to follow the “Fire alarm directives and the evacuation code of the grounds” and follow orders representatives of the Organizer, security personnel, or members of the rescue services. The fire alarm directives are addendum 1 of these Festival Rules and are their integral part.

#### 5. Other Provisions

5.1 The Organizer processes certain personal data as an administrator of personal data in accordance with Article 4 para. 7 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of Europe from 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (referred to from here only as “Regulation”). Complex information about the processing of personal data as part of Metronome Prague in accordance with Article 3 of the Regulation including the purpose of the individual acts in processing and the Attendees’ rights are listed in a separate document titled “Rules for Protecting Personal Data” that is available on the Organizer’s website (<https://metronome.cz>) and at the Festival.

5.2 By entering the Metronome Prague Festival grounds, Attendees agree without any objection to the free use of their image or likeness by the Organizer or their partners as part of a visual record, broadcast, or production that takes place within the Metronome Prague grounds for commercial or promotional use in accordance with para. 84 of law # 89/2012 Coll., of the Civic Code (referred to from here as “Civic Code”) when showing part of or the entire event that takes place within the Metronome Prague Festival grounds. Consent with use of images or likenesses is provided by the Attendee to the Organizer and their contractual partners for an indefinite period, while the Attendee is authorized to rescind this consent. The processing of personal data as part of making visual recordings is done according to the information about processing personal data in the previous paragraph.

5.3 Attendees of Metronome Prague acknowledge that audio or visual records may be recorded at Metronome Prague for use in the press, radio, television, or other news service. Attendees acknowledge that their consent is not necessary for the creation of these recordings in accordance with para. 89 of the Civic Code if these records are made in appropriate way and not in violation of their justified rights.

## 6. Parking

6.1 Attendees can use unmonitored parking lots where spaces are un-numbered, and their capacity is limited.

6.2 Attendees will be allowed access to the lots after showing a valid Festival ticket and will be given a parking ticket used for repeated entrance.

6.3 If the parking ticket is lost, the Attendee is obligated to immediately report the loss to the Organizer and will receive a replacement ticket for a fee of CZK 50 after providing identification.

6.4 Parking at the unmonitored lot is not legally enforceable and the purchase of a ticket does not entitle an Attendee to a parking space. The parking lot will open on 23.6.2022 at 14:00 and close 25.6.2022 at 24:00. All Attendees are obligated to vacate the lots by this deadline. If not, the vehicle will be towed at the expense of the owner or operator.

## 7. Further Provisions

7.1 Each Attendee will receive an ID band that must be visibly worn (i.e. on the wrist). The band gives the Attendee access to the tent area with the option of going back and forth. The ID band is non-transferrable. If damaged, the Attendee is obligated to demand it be exchanged by the Organizer. Each Attendee is obligated to show their band to representatives of the Organizer or security personnel. In case of loss of the ID band, the Attendee must immediately report its loss to the organizers and receive a replacement ID band at a cost of CZK 500 after providing identification.

7.2 All Attendees are obligated to leave the Festival grounds by 4:00 on 25.6.2022. Failure to do so will result in a late fee of CZK 500 to be paid in cash.

7.3 Attendees are obligated to follow the instructions from organizers and maintain social norms while adhering to the Organizer's general terms and conditions and these Festival Rules.

## 8. Final Provisions

8.1 The rules defined in this document can be supplemented by rules related to individual events at the Metronome Prague Festival grounds. These supplemental rules will be appropriately published within the Metronome Prague Festival grounds by the Organizer or security personnel and Attendees are obligated to adhere to them.

8.2 Addendum 1: Fire Alert Regulations are an intrinsic part of these Festival Rules.

8.3 These Festival Rules take effect on 1.1.2022

8.4 Any rights and obligations not specifically defined in these Festival Rules are defined by valid legal regulations, especially law # 89/2012 Coll., the Civic Code, in its valid form.

8.5 The Organizer reserves the right to alter these Festival Rules at any time.
